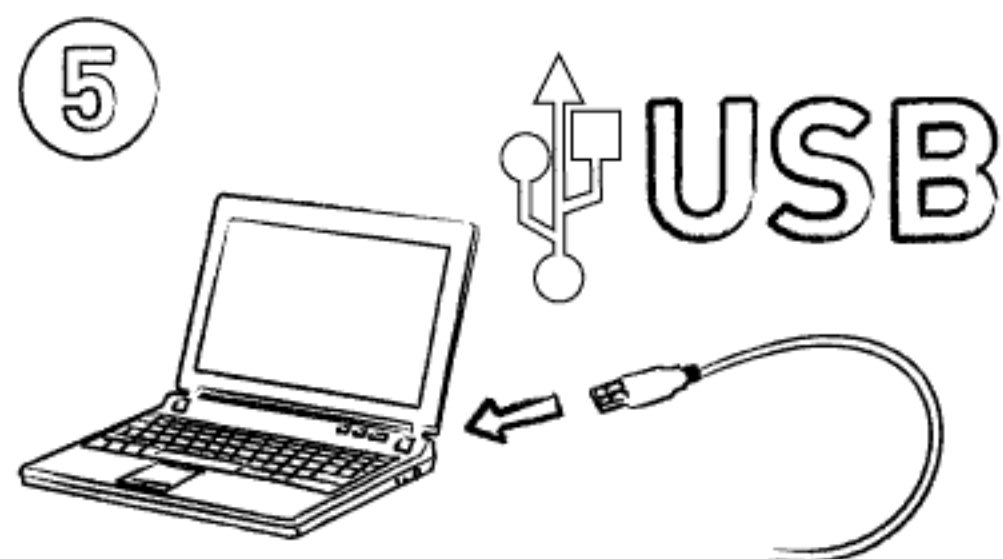
# TC-65 Modem Installation for laptop computers.



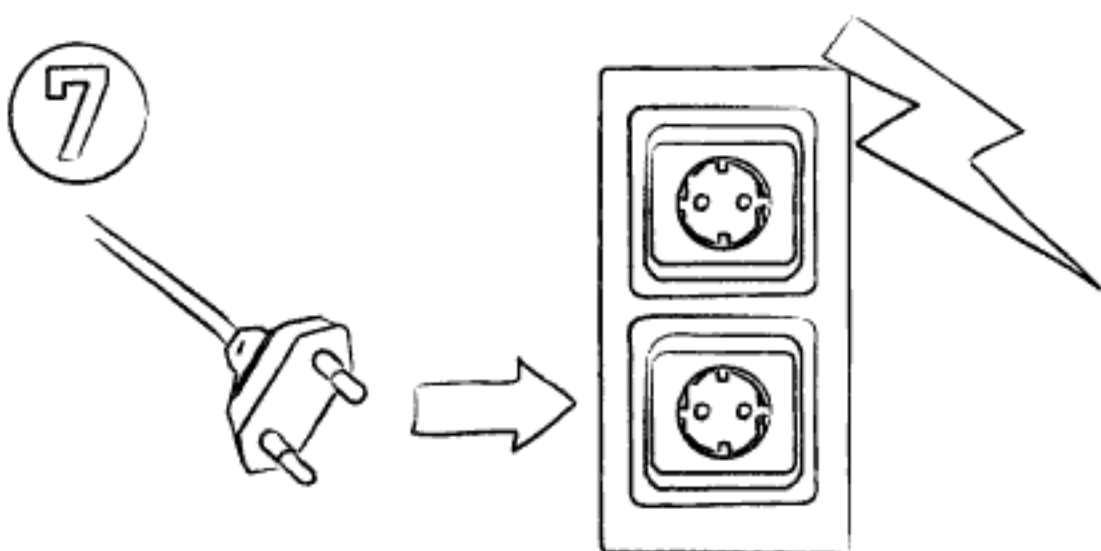
1 Setup TC-65 as in tabletop installation steps 1-5.



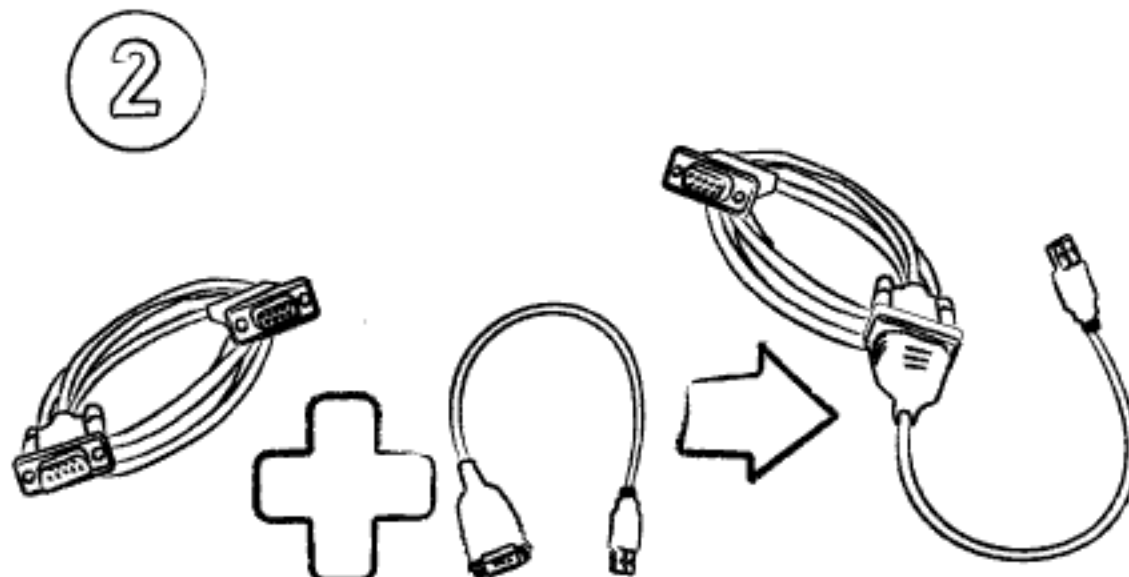
3 Insert the driver disk into the CD-Rom drive.



5 Connect the serial-USB adaptor to your USB port.



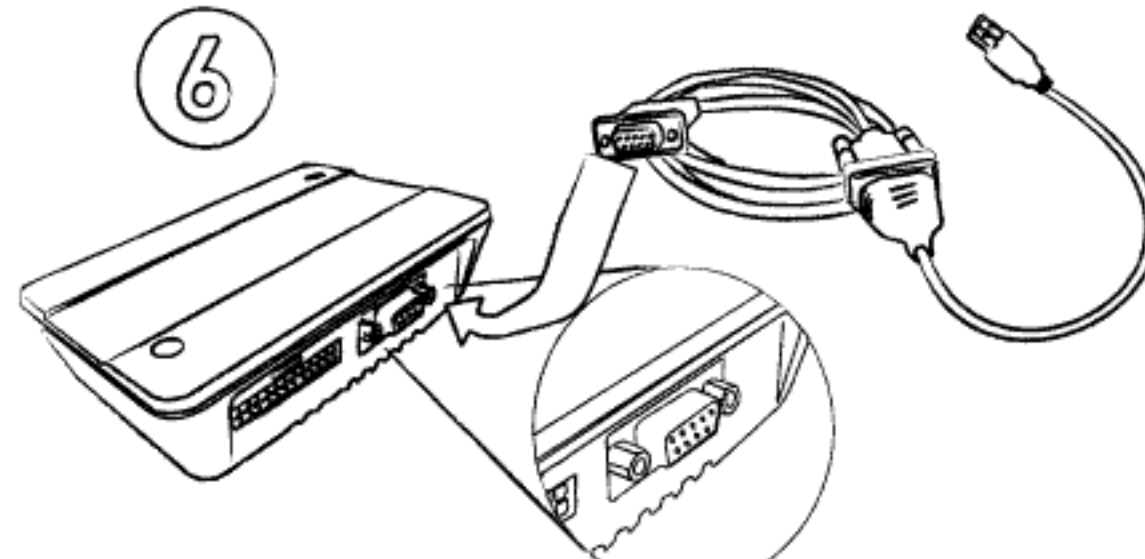
7 Plug in the power cable to an electricity socket.



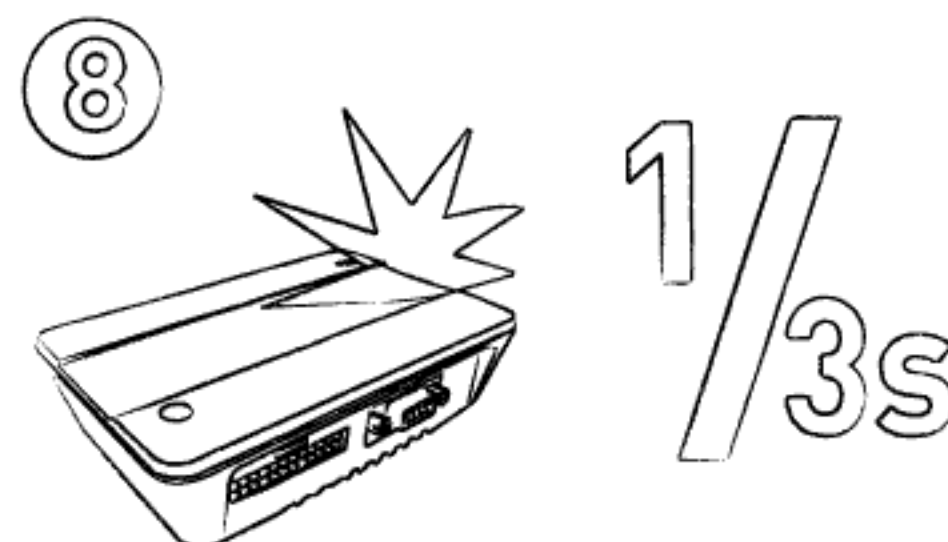
2 Connect the USB adaptor cable to the 9-pin modem cable.



4 Select your operating system and choose the drivers for serial to USB.

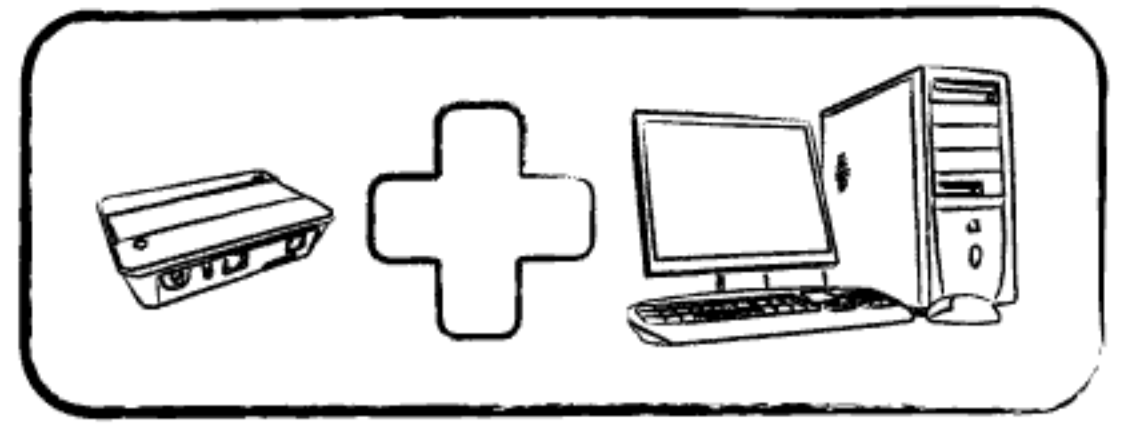


6 Connect the other end of the modem cable to your TC-65 Modem..

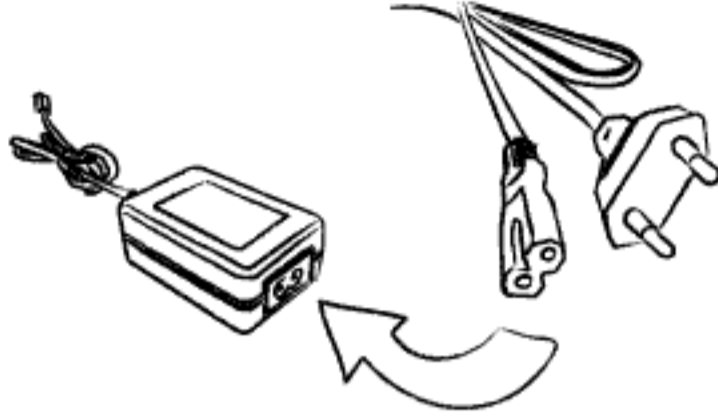


8 Observe the light. It should soon start blinking once every 3 seconds.

# TC-65 Modem Installation for desktop computers.

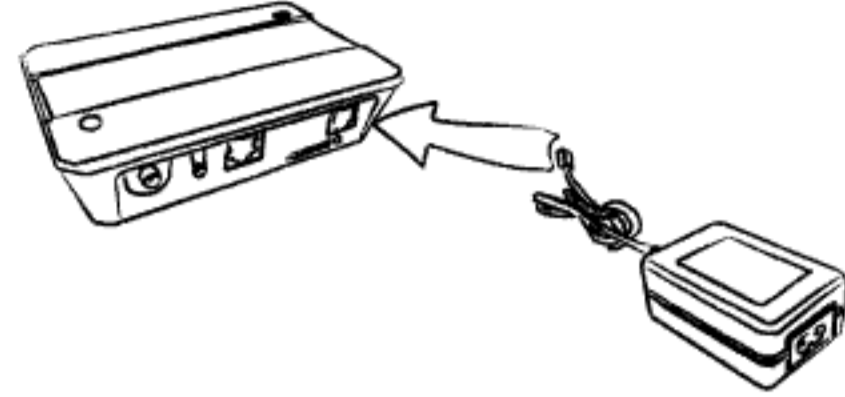

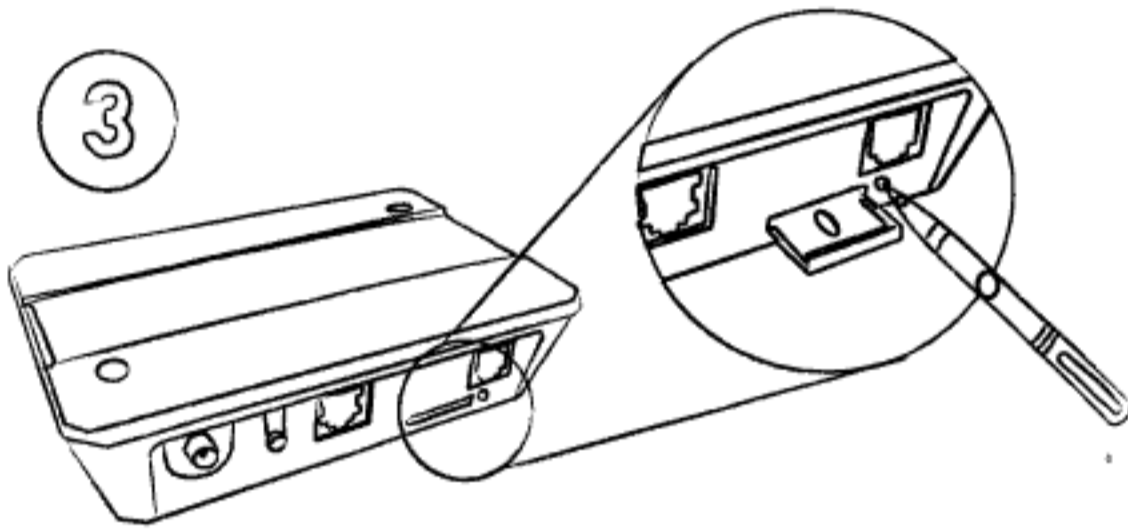
Connect power cord to power supply

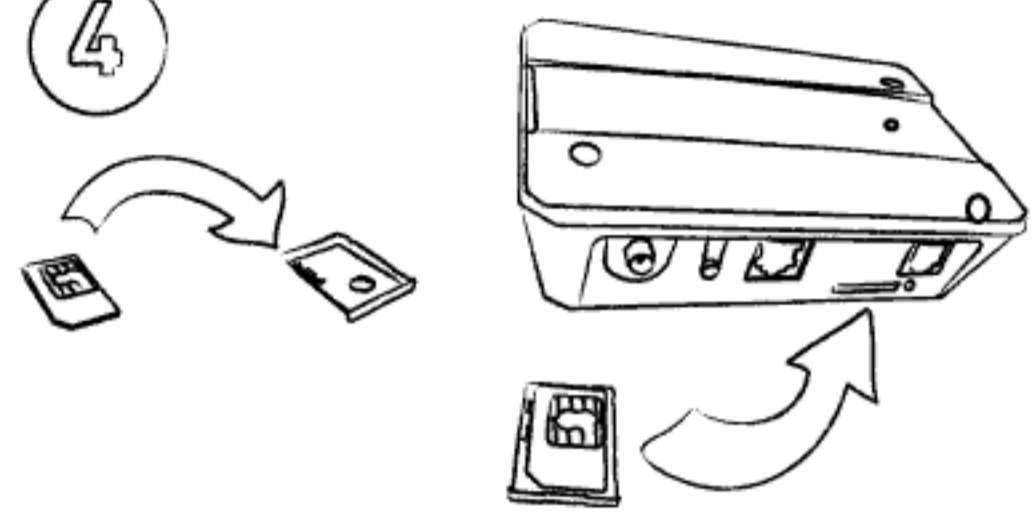
Connect power supply to the rightmost slot in the TC-65.

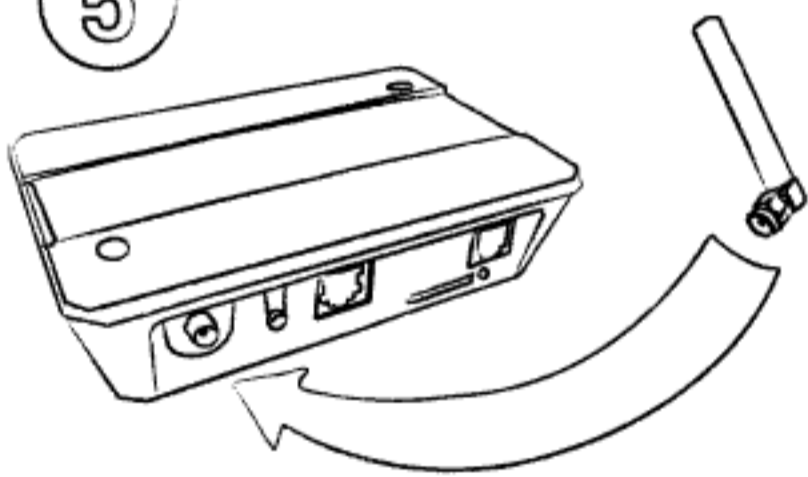
Open the SIM card slot by pressing the yellow button with a pointed object.

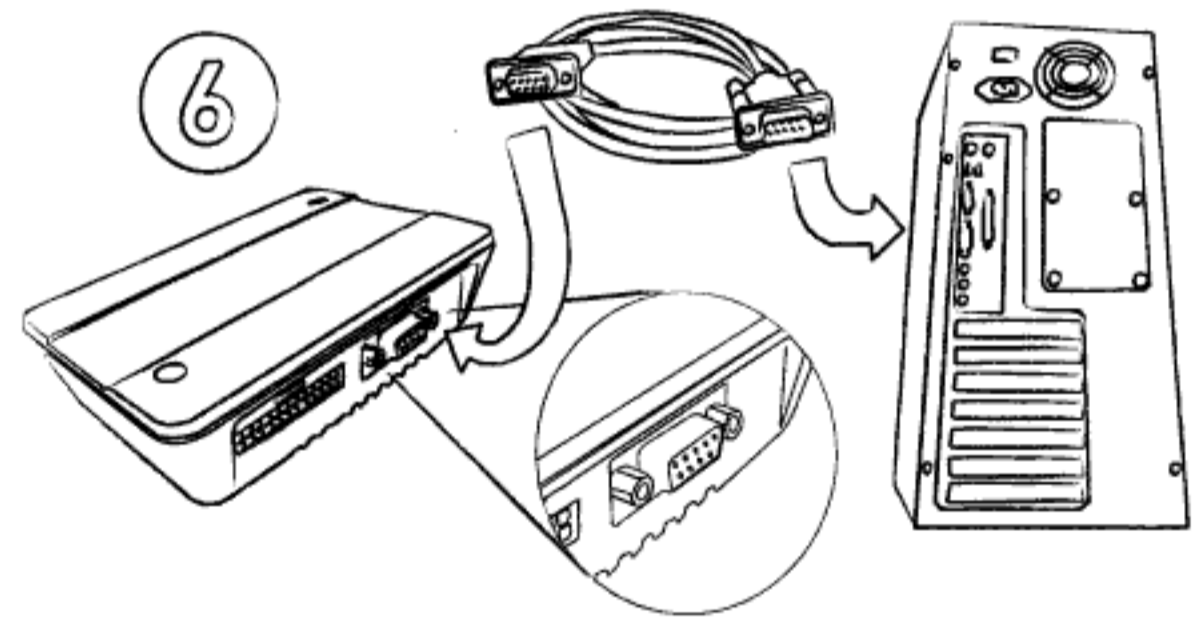
Install SIM with chip facing UP into the modem card slot.

5



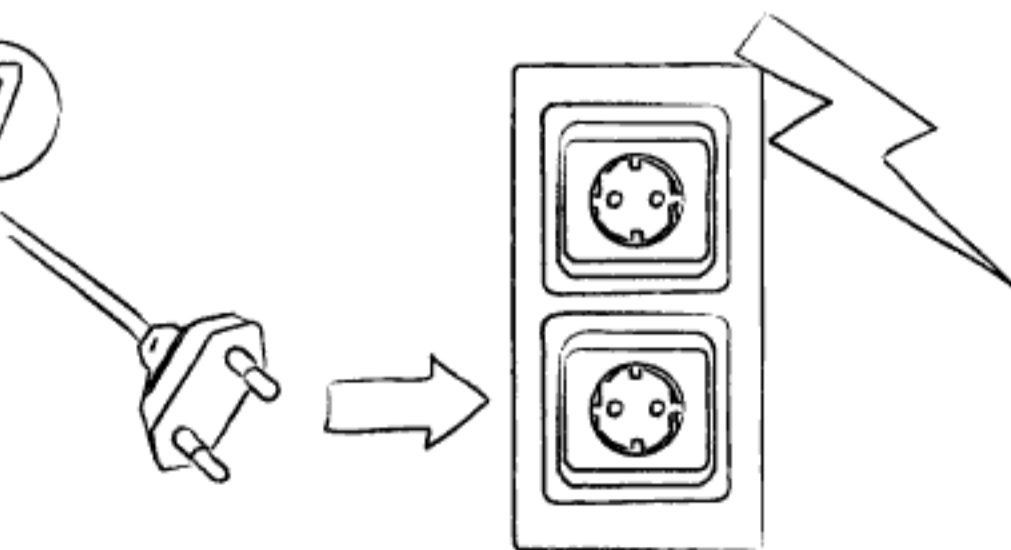
Attach and screw on the Antenna.

6



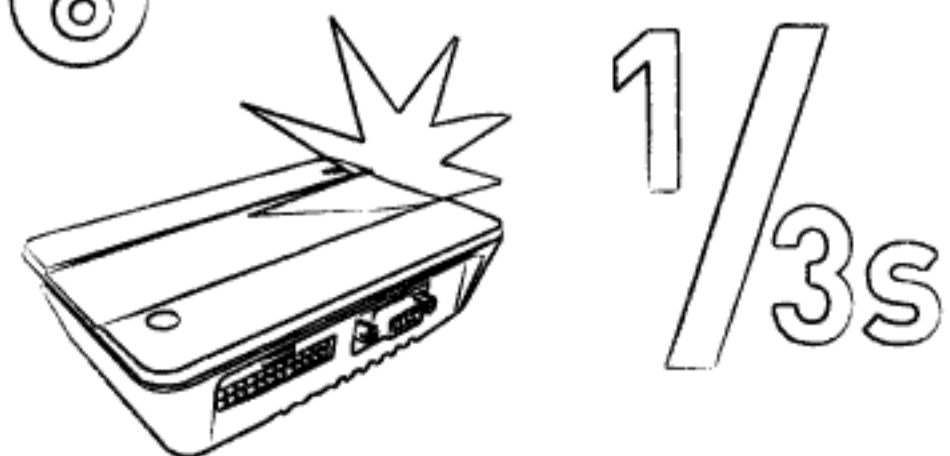
Connect the modem cable to the PC Com port.
